

Terms of Use for United in One Global Foundation

1. Introduction

Welcome to United in One Global Foundation ("United in One," "we," "us," or "our"). These Terms of Use ("Terms") govern your access to and use of our website, located at www.unitedinone.org, and any related services, content, or features offered by us (collectively, the "Website"). Our mission is to empower healthier, better-educated communities where everyone has access to clean water. These Terms help ensure a safe, reliable, and lawful environment for all our users.

Please read these Terms carefully.

2. Acceptance of Terms

By accessing, browsing, or using the Website, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms and our Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to these Terms, you may not access or use the Website. We reserve the right to modify these Terms at any time, with changes becoming effective immediately upon posting. Your continued use of the Website after any modification constitutes your acceptance of the new Terms.

3. Registration and Account Management

Some features on the Website may require you to register and create an account. As part of the registration process, you will be asked to provide accurate and complete information, and you may need to select a user name and password. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your account and password, for any activities that occur under your account, and for ensuring that account information is accurate and up to date. Donations are non-refundable except in the rare case of a processing error; contact us immediately if you believe an error has occurred.

Newsletter and Communications: If you donate, you are automatically enrolled in our newsletter and consent to receive email communications from United in One Global Foundation regarding our mission, programs, fundraising appeals, updates, and anything else. You may opt out at any time by following the unsubscribe instructions in our emails or by contacting us directly.

Charitable Solicitation Disclosure: United in One Global Foundation is a Florida nonprofit corporation and a registered 501(c)(3) organization. United in One is currently registered with

the State of Florida to solicit charitable contributions. We gratefully welcome and accept donations made through this Website from supporters located in any U.S. state or country, and nothing in this Section is intended to discourage or limit donations from residents of any jurisdiction.
